# ARE YOU UNDER 18 AND CHARGED WITH A CRIME?

WE'RE HERE TO HELP.



All youth in Alberta (aged 12-17) are eligible to receive a lawyer when charged with a crime. Contact us by phone at 1.886.845.3425. You can also talk to duty counsel (a lawyer to help you on the day of court) at your next court date.



#### DO YOU NEED HELP AT COURT?

We can provide a duty counsel lawyer (a lawyer to help you on the day of court) who can help you apply for a lawyer, help you at bail hearings, give you initial legal advice, or represent you at court until a lawyer is appointed for you.

#### **ARE YOU A PARENT OR GUARDIAN?**

You can't apply for legal aid on behalf of your child. All youth clients must contact Legal Aid Alberta directly by phone or speak to duty counsel at court.



### I AM A YOUTH AND HAVE AN INCOME. Can I still apply?

Yes. If you are a youth (age 12 to 17) who has been charged with a crime, you are eligible to receive representation by a lawyer through Legal Aid Alberta.
